Groves Conference on Marriage and Family **FELDMAN AWARD**

The Feldman Award, in honor of Harold and Margaret Feldman, both early and outstanding leaders in the fields of family and policy, is given to an author or authors of a peer-reviewed journal article or book chapter published within the last 5 years that makes a significant social policy contribution related to ethnicity and/or gender and that is also supportive of the theme of the Groves Conference annual meeting. The 2011 conference will be held from March 14 to 18 in New Orleans, Louisiana with the theme:

Families, Climate, and Environment: Change and Interchange

The 2011 Groves Conference will focus on the two faces of New Orleans—a world of families living in the aftermath of Katrina and the Gulf oil spill and another of Mardi Gras, Bourbon Street, and all that jazz—and the challenges of living in an increasingly fragile world.

The award consists of a \$1,000 honorarium and reimbursement for conference-attendance expenses (travel, hotel, meals, etc.) up to an additional \$1,000. The award winner(s) must be able to attend the conference and present their work.
